### *Senior Intercounties*

The Senior Intercounties Tournament takes place at Exeter on Sunday 18 September 2005. Congratulations to all our archers who have been selected to shoot for their County on this occasion and the best of luck to them.

A scratch match was shot against Somerset earlier in the Summer at the Somerset County Championships and the DCAS archers who were there on the day (*not our official team or a full team, but many of them*) shot brilliantly, particularly the Compounds. They were narrowly beaten by the Somerset team, but that's hardly surprising when **all** their best archers would have been at their County Championships. The performance of the DCAS archers bodes well for the Intercounties Tournament.
