#### Junction Archers - Small but beautifully formed!

Frank Bath started archery in late 2006 with Bristol Bowmen and Golden Phoenix Archers. Whilst with the club he held many positions, including chair, treasurer and club nurse as well as qualifying as a Level 1 coach and remained there until he moved to Halwill Junction, in late 2011.

After settling into the area, Frank set about looking for an archery club to join, but the closest Archery GB club Frank could find was near Bideford and he soon realised that the journey time made it an unviable proposition and hence the idea of Junction Archers was born.

In a matter of weeks Frank managed to secure the offer of both outdoor and indoor venues and funding from Torridge District Council via Active Villages, order equipment, get his friend Sheena (the web master at Bristol Bowmen and Golden Phoenix Archers) to design the web site, have a logo professionally designed and register the club with Archery GB. Junction Archers is three clubs in one: a general adult club, one for young people under the age of 18 and one for disabled people. Although we are three clubs, we shoot together as one club and have a single committee. Our membership has grown in the last six months to over 25 members, some of whom are shown below.

The 2012 GWAS Regional Junior Championships incorporating the Junior Intercounties Championship, was hosted by Burnham Archers and held at the superb BASC sports field in Burnham on Sea. Four County Teams took part: Devon & Cornwall, Dorset & Wilts, Gloucester and Somerset.

And so the tale began when 13 DCAS archers, chauffeurs and supporters set off at what appeared to be the crack of dawn from various westerly coordinates on 22<sup>nd</sup> September, some to represent County for the very first time. Everyone had arrived safely and signed in, so John Russell gathered all together for a Team chat, to hand out badges, bars and jackets and let everyone know the format for the day.

After the regulatory advice from the judges the tournament began, shooting the Albion round for the older participants and age appropriate Windsor rounds for the others.

At the end of the rounds and after tea provided by the hosts and further deliberation by the Organisers and Judges, the Head to Head Competition at 30 yards started and all of DCAS Juniors shot really well in the knockout format competition.

Now I am not one for gossip and I am not mentioning any names, however, they had to search long and hard for one compound archer's arrow, lost at 30 yards on a H2H round; I suspect some folks will never let the poor lad forget.

Not all Fairytales have happy endings and although the DCAS Team did not win this year, it gave the opportunity for our Juniors to come together to experience full tournament conditions as a team and a wonderful day out for participants and supporters alike.

Although not shooting for the DCAS team this year, Michael Bryan-Harris won an individual medal; 1<sup>st</sup> Gents Recurve.

We are really proud of all of our DCAS Juniors and look forward to seeing you at the indoor training sessions. Look out GWAS, we are already planning for 2013.

#### **Record Claims Reminder**

For anyone wanting to claim a DCAS County record, please remember that you have only **four weeks** from the date of the tournament to do this and **three months** for GWAS. GWAS Regional Record Claims should be sent via your DCAS CRO.

Claim forms are available on DCAS and GWAS websites respectively and as DCAS CRO I usually carry a few blank forms to tournaments; you can also hand completed forms to me personally at any shoot I attend.

Claims can be made from scores achieved at any Open Tournament, including 'Masters' claims for archers aged 50+, many of which remain as yet unclaimed, in addition to regular record claims. All claims from outside County must be accompanied by a copy of the results sheet. So come on fellow 'Masters', where are you?

Thanks and I look forward to another exciting year of claims, as 2012 has been a good year for DCAS archers ;o)
