



Devon and Cornwall Archery Society Virtual Outdoor Fun County Championships

Due to the Covid-19 Pandemic, DCAS and Exmouth Archers were unable to run the County Championships as previously planned. However, we are aware that most DCAS Clubs have the ability to shoot outdoors, even if this is on a limited basis, so we have opted to shoot the County Champs as a postal.

The rounds will be:

Ladies and Gents Recurve and Longbow

World Archery 70m round (6 dozen arrows at 70m on a 122cm face)

Ladies and Gents Compound

World Archery 50m round (6 dozen arrows at 50m on a 80cm face)

Ladies and Gents Barebow

World Archery 50m Barebow round (6 dozen arrows at 50m on a 122cm face)

Juniors may opt to shoot the adult rounds, the WA 60m Cadet round or the equivalent Archery GB rounds. But the round chosen must be appropriate to age.

All juniors under 18

World Archery 60m Cadet round – (6 dozen arrows at 60m on a 122cm face)

Junior Gents or Ladies under 16, 14 or 12

Archery GB 122-50 round – (6 dozen arrows at 50m on a 122cm face)

Junior Gents or Ladies under 14 or 12

Archery GB 122-40 round - (6 dozen arrows at 40m on a 122cm face)

Junior Gents or Ladies under 12

Archery GB 122-30 round - (6 dozen arrows at 30m on a 122cm face)

Junior Gents under 14 or 12

Archery GB 80-40 round - (6 dozen arrows at 40m on a 80cm face)

Junior Ladies under 14 or 12

Archery GB 80-30 round – (6 dozen arrows at 30m on a 80cm face)

Rounds may be shot over more than one day if Club sessions do not allow the full 6 dozen to be shot in one go. 6 sighters only may be taken at the start of each shooting session.

Scores will be submitted to the organiser via lanseo and its phone app lanseo Scorekeeper. You are probably familiar with this as its been used for a number of years at tournaments in DCAS. More details on how to set this up will be sent when you enter.

You may shoot more than once but your final chosen score must be submitted by midnight on the 13th September.

Awards will be given based upon entries and classes.
