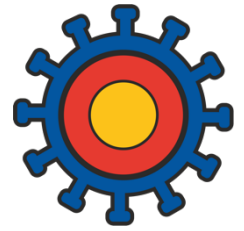




# Devon and Cornwall Archery Society Indoor Championships 2022



The DCAS Committee have looked at whether it is sensible to run the Indoor Championships at Plymouth and given the current state of the Covid pandemic, we feel that it is important to protect our members and volunteers and as such we will be cancelling the physical event. We would like to thank Yelverton Bowmen and the YMCA for supporting us in this decision.

Instead we will run the County Championships as a postal event, but not quite in the same format as other replacement postals that we, and GWAS have done recently.

We are asking those DCAS clubs that have Archers that wish to participate to nominate one of their normal weekly shooting sessions as their "leg" of the championships. We ask that for the Archers wishing to participate, during that session that the WA18m round is run as formally as it can be. Ideally with a Field Captain taking control of the shooting and dealing with any Judging issues that may crop up such as line cutters. The Field Captain may also shoot and participate, but may not deal with their own line cutters!

Compound Archers will shoot on a 3 spot face, Recurve, Longbow, Barebow and Juniors on a single full face although anyone may shoot on a 3 spot if they wish. If possible, new faces should be used.

As we do not want this to a drawn out process Clubs must nominate one session anytime from 8am Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> February to midnight Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> March. Hopefully this will give all clubs the ability to set aside one of their normal sessions. However if this causes a problem with venues then please contact the Organiser for advice. Likewise if a Club venue cannot handle the number of members that wish to shoot all at the same time, multiple legs will be allowed at the discretion of the event Organiser.

We ask that each Club nominates one contact to liaise with the Organiser, and they will be responsible for collating scores, which will need to be returned to the Organiser within 24 hours of the session being shot.

Archers wishing to participate must register with the event Organiser, once the Club has nominated their "Leg", date and time. Entries will be via a web form and an appropriate closing date will apply. Club Contacts should make this very clear to their members. We will not be able to accept last minute entries.

Archers may shoot at a different Club "Leg" by arrangement with that Club and notified to the Organiser via their entry but they may only shoot the Championships once. Scores may not be bettered and duplicate scores will be ignored. Especially where a Club has multiple "Legs" setup for capacity and in this circumstance, Archers should still nominate their chosen leg.

Ianseos will be used for scoring and the event Organiser will provide scoresheets for each archer participating, via the nominated club contact. Scores may be passed back either by entering them via the Ianseos Scorekeeper phone application during or after the actual leg or via scans/photos of the paper scoresheet, noting the 24 hour deadline. Clubs will be responsible for printing their own scoresheets.

DCAS will award medals as we would at a normal Indoor Champs...

DCAS awards for Ladies and Gentlemen Recurve/Compound/Longbow/Barebow

DCAS Junior age groups Recurve/Compound/Longbow/Barebow (according to entries)

DCAS Team awards: Recurve Team of 4 archers: Compound Team of 3 archers; Junior Recurve team of 3 archers (*teams picked from highest scoring archers from same club*)

Jack & Jill teams Rec/CU/Longbow (team of one Lady and one Gent from same club – *please advise partners name on the web form*)

Medals awarded in bow styles as follows - 1<sup>st</sup> – 1 Archer, 2<sup>nd</sup> – 4 Archers, 3<sup>rd</sup> – 7 or more archers

In addition we will also award medals to Novices, who will be Archers in their first year of shooting, as we know some Clubs have managed to run Beginners Courses recently.

Results will be made available on [ianseo.net](http://ianseo.net) as soon as all Clubs have shot their “Legs” and the scores are processed. Medals will be posted to the nominated club contact as soon as is practicable. 2020 Trophy winners are asked to keep the trophies safe until later in the year.
