From A30 (from east) and M5 Junction 29 (other directions), follow 'EXETER A3015' and then 'CITY CENTRE B3183'.

Keep straight on for approx. 1 mile, then fork left at traffic lights (signposted '**RDE HOSPITAL WONFORD, COUNTY HALL, St LUKES**). Do not follow sign 'RDE Hospital Heavitree'.

At next junction (traffic lights) keep straight on into **Magdalen Road** (signposted **UNIVERSITY, St LUKES**). In approx. 175yds, take second left into **VICTORIA PARK ROAD**.

Entrance and all parking is at far end of school playing field, adjacent to the pavilion. Entry via PIN code (to be advised).

Please inform tournament organiser if you have restricted mobility and we will do our best to accommodate a suitable parking space for you.
