This clarification is specifically intended to cover Juniors invited to attend the Regional Academy - we look forward to supporting our Juniors as they qualify!

Also a reminder that DCAS will make interest-free loans of up to £400 to enable Juniors - at any level - to buy equipment. We know that kids tend to out-grow their arrows at the most inconvenient times! Please make sure that parents of your Juniors are aware of this funding option.

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Changes to County Team Selection

The selection criteria for the Senior County Team have been modified for 2015. Selection will now be based on FOUR 12 dozen rounds at a minimum distance appropriate to the archer's gender. One of these rounds must be

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shot between the last weekend in July and the 30th August. The Team will then be picked based upon the handicaps obtained for those rounds. For details see the DCAS website.

It is a condition of selection for the County Team that the archer agrees to wear the official County Colours throughout the day. The shooting top was introduced in October 2014 and will be provided by DCAS, lower garments will be self funded with black preferred but with green or white acceptable.

Please bring these changes to the attention of any archers in your Club who aspire to represent their County.
