**Rounds** Ladies and Gentlemen's World Record Status WA18m  
Junior WA18m - for ages Under 18; under 15 and under 12.



All Compound archers will shoot on individual 40cm 3-spot faces. (Junior Compound archers please note on entry form if would prefer to shoot on a 40cm full face). All other archers on individual 40cm full face.

**Session 1 will be 2 archers per boss shooting in a single detail. Sessions 2 and 3 will be 4 archers per boss shooting in 2 details. Arrows will be shot in 2-minute timed ends of 3 arrows. Timing will be by Danage timers.**

Equipment Inspection will take place prior to practice

Only members of Archery GB or World Archery Federation are permitted to shoot at this tournament. Membership cards must be shown at registration.

**Note:** When you enter the competition, the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists, and results may be published showing first names, surname, gender, bow style, date of birth/age category, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round, Disabled (Y/N), Disability Info. By signing the entry form you are agreeing to this.

**Drug Testing** Record status shoots will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. A refusal will be treated as a positive result

**Dress** Archers must comply with Archery GB rule 307

**Notes** Please wear soft non-marking shoes in the sports hall. The Hall is heated but not over warm.
