Rounds	In the morning: A LONGBOW TOURNAMENT 2-way Longbow National (60/50) This will be open to Archery GB members and BLBS members. Trophies awarded to Archery GB members only, BLBS members will be awarded DCAS medals. BLBS members are not eligible to enter afternoon National Rounds.
	In the afternoon: OPEN NATIONAL ROUNDS National (60/50yds) – Open, Women, and U18 Junior Open, U21 Jr Open and Jr Women National 50 (50/40yds) – U16 Junior Open, U18 Junior Women National 40 (40/30yds) - U14 Junior Open, U16 Junior Women National 30 (30/20yds) - U12 Junior Open, U14 Junior Women

There will be 4 archers per boss shooting in 2 details. Arrows will be shot in 4-minute timed ends of 6 arrows on straw bosses.

Awards	Morning: Trophies and Medals for DCAS Open and Women Most Hits, Highest Score, Most Golds, and First Gold. Medals for Juniors and BLBS members DCAS Team of 2 on Golds. Afternoon: DCAS Open Recurve (National round) – Silver Quiver DCAS Women Recurve (National round) – Manadon Bowl Trophies for DCAS Open and Women Compound/Longbow/Barebow (National Round) Medals will be awarded in all classes as follows: 1st - 1 Archer, 2nd - 4 Archers, 3rd – 7 or more Archers. Visitor medals will be awarded for Morning and Afternoon rounds. All awards are subject to the discretion of the TO and only awarded to competitors present at the ceremony. Archers may enter rounds above their age group if desired and will be eligible for awards.

Due to changes at the school the number of bosses must be restricted so please send entries in early to avoid disappointment.

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Special Requirements: To help us accommodate any special requirements you may have, please note them on your entry and discuss them with the Tournament Organiser. Please also note on entry if you have restricted mobility and we will do our best to accommodate a suitable parking space for you. Wheelchair users may be asked to stay on the line and not travel to the bosses to collect arrows depending on weather conditions to preserve the school field.

Dress : Archers must comply with Archery GB rule 307

Carbon arrows - No "all carbon" arrows are to be used as it is multi use school sports field. This is a conditional requirement of DCAS using the venue. If an archer is found to be shooting carbon arrows they will be asked to leave the field. Also, no arrows of any type can be left unaccounted for at the end of the shoot, and it is the archer's responsibility to find their missing arrows.

Age groups - Are based on a calendar year, e.g. if an archer turns 16 at any time during the year they will enter as U18. Because of the numbers involved we will not be offering a 50 plus category of entry

Archery GB member/Declaration – when signing the entry form you are declaring that you will comply with all Archery GB rules and codes of conduct, and that you are a paid-up member of Archery GB or World Archery (Please ensure you bring evidence of membership **as it will be checked at registration**)

Note: When you enter the competition, the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists, and results may be published showing first names, surname, gender, bow style, date of birth/age category, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round, Disabled (Y/N), Disability Info. By signing the entry form you are agreeing to this.

From **A30** (from east) and **M5 Junction 29** (other directions), follow 'EXETER A3015' and then 'CITY CENTRE B3183'.

Keep straight on for approx. 1 mile, then fork left at traffic lights (signposted 'RDE HOSPITAL WONFORD, COUNTY HALL, St LUKES'). Do not follow sign 'RDE Hospital Heavitree'.

At next junction (traffic lights) keep straight on into **Magdalen Road** (signposted **UNIVERSITY, St LUKES**). In approx. 175yds, take second left into **VICTORIA PARK ROAD**.

Entrance and all parking is at far end of school playing field, adjacent to the pavilion. Entry via PIN code (to be advised when target list is sent out).

School requirements for use of school ground: No Dogs are allowed on the field. No smoking is allowed on school premises.
